- SWIM FORMAT:** Two-day meet. 4A will begin at 9:30 a.m. on Thursday for prelims and 7:30 a.m. on Saturday for finals. 2A/1A will begin at 1:50 p.m. on Thursday for prelims and 2:00 p.m. on Saturday for finals.
- DIVE FORMAT:** Two-day meet. 4A, 3A & 2A/1A will begin at 10:00 a.m. on Friday for prelims. 4A, 3A & 2A/1A diving finals will begin at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday.
- SCORING:** 16-place scoring will be in effect for both classes.
- QUALIFYING TO STATE:** 4A- *3 Swimmers/Divers in each event will qualify for the State meet
2A/1A- *4 Swimmers/Divers in each event will qualify for the State meet
* Additional entries may qualify via wildcard system thru WIAA/WISCA

- RULES:** National Federation rules will be followed, as well as any WIAA swim & dive rules.
- GAMES COMMITTEE:** The Games Committee shall consist of the site manager, officials director and meet referee (or others to be named due to conflict of interest). Its duties shall be those identified by the National Federation and WIAA and any other duties deemed appropriate by the Officials Director. Decisions of the Games committee are final.
- CROWD CONTROL:** Pep banners, confetti, mascots, and mechanical or artificial noisemakers, including band instruments used as noisemakers are not permitted at any of the tournaments.
- FINANCES:** Tournament managers will send all receipts and expenditures to the NCWAA district director within one week of the end of the tournament.
- RESULTS:** The qualifiers for the next level must be reported immediately following the completion of the tournament to the District Director and the WIAA Office.
