ROSTERS: Please email rosters to tournament manager on Wednesday, May 13th

PASSES: Pass list and rosters due to tournament manager on the Wednesday, May 13th.

TOURNAMENT RULES:

RULES: National Federation rules and WIAA State Baseball Tournament guidelines will be followed (including those for courtesy runners, “run rules” and length of games. The tournament manager or umpires in charge will explain any ground rules.

INFIELD/HITTING Each team will be allowed 10 minute infield prior to their first game only.

 Pregame batting practice will be allowed in batting cages located on site.

BALLS: Each school must furnish its own warm-up balls. Game balls will be the official WIAA baseball and will be provided by the tournament manager.

SELECTION OF HOME TEAM: The team at the bottom of each bracket will be designated as the home team for all rounds of play.

LINE-UP CARDS: Each coach must deliver their batting order to the umpire and official scorekeeper on line-up cards and provide the press box with an official line-up card including first and last names.

UMPIRES: Three WOA certified umpires will be assigned to each game. The home athletic director tournament site manager will contact the local assignor(s) to assign umpires for games.

POSTPONED GAMES: When necessary to postpone any tournament game, it shall be the responsibility of the tournament site manager to re-schedule according to WIAA policy. The tournament site manager will have a plan for rainouts worked out in advance. The WIAA will be informed in the event of a rainout reschedule.
