5 Teams

ADMISSION PRICES:

Adults \$8.00

Coaches and athletic directors who are members of their respective professional associations will be admitted to all District 6 events, provided they produce their membership card and photo ID prior to entry.

PASS POLICY:

Twenty (20) players

Five (5) designated school personnel (coaches, managers, statisticians, etc.)

One (1) bat boy/girl

One (1) medical

Two (2) supervisors

AWARDS:

A district championship trophy will be presented to the first place team.

FINANCES:

The site manager will send the financial report to the district director who will pay all tournament expenses.

TOURNAMENT RULES:

RULES:	National Federation rules and WIAA State Baseball Tournament guidelines will be followed. The tournament manager or umpires in charge will explain any ground rules.
BATTING PRACTICE:	Will be allowed on game day provided the game site can accommodate. Participating teams must contact the site manager in advance to set up a time.
INFIELD PRACTICE:	10 minutes will be allowed for each squad.
BALLS:	District 6 will provide game balls
SELECTION OF HOME TEAM:	The highest seed shall be the home team and the lower seed gets the choice of dugout.
LINE-UP CARDS:	Each coach must deliver their batting order to the umpire and official scorekeeper on line-up cards.
UMPIRES:	The District 6 Director will acquire the umpires for the tournament and the site manager will assign all umpires to individual games.
RUN RULE:	The ten run rule will <u>BE</u> in effect.
VIDEO TAPE POLICY:	Same as WIAA state policy.
BROADCASTING:	District policy will be followed. (\$60 per game payment on site.)
FAN POLICY:	The District 6 Executive Board has ruled that pep banners, confetti, signs, mascots (costumed mascots are acceptable), and mechanical or artificial noisemakers including band instruments used as noisemakers, are not permitted at any of the tournaments. (1980)
MEDICAL AID:	A doctor will be present or on call.
