Games Committee:	The games committee shall consist of the CTL Athletic Director in charge of soccer, the center official and a District 6 Athletic Director. In the event that the CTL Athletic Director in charge of soccer's school is involved in the dispute, a second District 6 Athletic Director shall replace him/her.		

Tournament Rules

- The tournament sites will be determined by placement on the bracket. The team on the bottom half of the bracket hosts. Game times for Tuesday, November 6th are 4 PM. Game times for November 6th are 4 PM.
- The CTL Athletic Director for soccer is in charge of contacting the assigning secretary to arrange referees for district games.
- Home team wears white and away team wears dark uniforms.

- Game balls must be provided by the home team.
- Report all results to me at the email address above, so I can arrange for referees.
- The FIFA Rulebook and WIAA handbook will be followed for all contests.
- Games that are tied after two 5-minute overtime periods will result in a shoot-out between the two teams. Each team will select five players, alternate kicks between teams and each player receives one kick at the opponent's goal. If the game is still tied at the end of the first shoot-off, 5 different players are selected for each team. Teams alternate kicks, but the second shoot-off is sudden death.

Start Time: Games during the weekday will start at 4 PM. Games on Saturday are 2 PM.
