## TOURNAMENT GENERAL INFORMATION:

DATE:	January 26, 2016
NUMBER OF TEAMS:	Top four teams from 4A League Play in the CBBN as well as the Top 10 Individuals not on qualifying teams
SITE :	Highest Seed (League Champion)
SPORT MANAGER:	Loren Sandhop, Moses Lake
TOURNAMENT FORMAT:	District Tournament will be a one-day tournament consisting of 3 regular and 7 baker games. The top 10 total individuals from non-qualifying schools/teams who have bowled in 50% of the scheduled league matches within the league will qualify to bowl in the 3 regular games. From these games, the individual state berth will be determined.
TEAM(S) QUALIFYING TO STATE:	The top Team with the highest pin count after all 10 games advance to State. The top 2 Individuals not on the qualifying teams advance to State by their 3 Regular Game total pins.
ADMISSION PRICES:	N/A
AWARDS:	Award will be given to the District Champion

## TOURNAMENT RULES:

RULES:	USBC rules will be followed, as well as any WIAA bowling rules.
GAMES COMMITTEE:	The Games Committee shall consist of the site manager and two participating coaches not involved in the dispute in question. Its duties shall be those identified by the National Federation and WIAA and any other duties deemed appropriate by the Event Director. Decisions of the Games committee are final.
TEAM BENCH:	The team bench is limited to the same number of people as the state guidelines.
CROWD CONTROL:	Pep banners, confetti, mascots, and mechanical or artificial noisemakers, including band instruments used as noisemakers are not permitted at any of the tournaments.
FINANCES:	Tournament managers will send all receipts and expenditures to the NCWAA district director within one week of the end of the tournament.
RESULTS:	The qualifiers for the next level must be reported immediately following the completion of the tournament to the District Director and the WIAA Office.
